## UTICA PUBLIC LIBRARY WIRELESS INTERNET USE POLICY

## **Policy Statement**

The Utica Public Library offers wireless internet for all patrons wishing to access it. However, as there are only three outlets available for patrons to plug in their computers, the following policy has been enacted:

- Patrons using electrical outlets provided by the library are limited to two hours of wireless internet use per day using these outlets unless extended time has been permitted by library staff.
- 2. Patrons not needing electrical outlets and/or using their own computer batteries may use the wireless as long as they wish during library hours.
- 3. Patrons may not use extension cords to connect to library outlets; such cords are a liability to the other patrons. Nor may patrons rearrange library tables and chairs to gain access to electrical outlets.
- 4. Patrons must use one of the three outlets the library provides for wireless use:
  - A. In the North East corner by the magazine area
  - B. On the North wall next to the historic filing cabinets
  - C. At the desk facing Memorial Park next to the Audiobooks on the West wall
